Dear Ms. Dortch:

On October 24, 2008, Anna Gomez, Charles McKee and I met with Scott Bergmann of Commissioner Adelstein's office to discuss intercarrier compensation and USF reform. Consistent with our previous advocacy in these proceedings, Sprint Nextel emphasized the need for prompt transition to uniform cost-based terminating rates and immediate action on traffic pumping. We also urged retention of the identical support rule, but recommended that if the Commission nonetheless eliminates this rule, that it should adopt a reasonable transition plan from existing rules to a new support mechanism for competitive carriers.
