This filing submits additional letters from paging customers of USA Mobility, Inc. regarding the potential imposition of numbers-based universal service fees. I earlier submitted similar letters urging the Commission to refrain from imposing significant increases in the universal service charges borne by paging carriers and their customers. Such fee increases would jeopardize hospitals' and other health care providers' ability to purchase paging services—and in turn impact patient safety and emergency response operations.
