This *ex parte* letter is submitted on behalf of GTA Telecom, LLC (“GTA”), in the above-referenced proceedings. From press and industry reports, GTA understands that the proposed order in these proceedings that may be considered at the scheduled agenda meeting on November 4, 2008, includes exemptions for Alaska, Hawaii, and Puerto Rico from certain intercarrier compensation and/or universal service rules. As stated in its *ex parte* letter dated October 22, 2008, GTA requests that the Commission consider the unique issues associated with providing telecommunications services in Guam and, as appropriate, apply the same rules to Guam and other non-contiguous U.S. territories as to Alaska and Hawaii.
