On October 28, 2008, the undersigned, counsel to the Wireless Internet Service Providers Association (“WISPA”), left a voice-mail message for Bruce Gottlieb, legal advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps, regarding WISPA’s **“licensed-lite” approach for fixed rural broadband service**. The message informed Mr. Gottlieb that, based on other meetings between WISPA representatives and Commission staff, WISPA believes the door is open for the Commission to adopt WISPA’s proposal. WISPA requested that Commissioner Copps voice support for inclusion of the “licensed-lite” solution in the Commission’s Order.
