On October 27, 2008, Larry Page, President of Products and co-founder of Google Inc. (“Google”), talked by telephone with Commissioner Michael Copps concerning the TV white spaces proceeding. During the course of the conversation, Mr. Page urged the Commissioner to support the draft white spaces order, as a means of providing ubiquitous, low-cost broadband Internet access to all consumers. Mr. Page also discussed the feasibility of Google’s “variable power control” proposal for white space devices using channels adjacent to licensed digital television signals.
