On Wednesday, October 29, 2008, David Donovan, president of MSTV, contacted the following individuals regarding the above captioned matter: Rick Chessen, senior legal advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps; Angela Giancarlo, chief of staff to Commissioner Robert McDowell; Renée Crittendon, legal advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and Wayne Leighton, legal advisor to Commissioner Deborah Tate.

I asked each of the legal advisors whether they would be interested in attending a joint meeting of all the legal advisors and the Office of Engineering and Technology. The purpose of the meeting would be to 1) outline the interference problems resulting from placing a 40 milliwatt unlicensed device on the first adjacent channel, and 2) discuss problems with the FCC's publically stated process for allowing some devices to be placed in the band using "sensing" to avoid interference.
