On behalf of Cyren Call Communications Corporation ("Cyren Call"), and in accordance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206(b), undersigned counsel hereby submits the instant notice of an *ex parte* presentation.

On October 30, 2008, Morgan O'Brien, Chairman of Cyren Call, Bruce Cox, Senior Vice President – External Affairs of Cyren Call, and undersigned counsel, had a telephone conversation with Angela E. Giancarlo, Chief of Staff & Senior Legal Advisor, Wireless & International, to Commissioner Robert M. McDowell.

Ms. Giancarlo advised the Cyren Call participants that, contrary to statements reported to them, she was unaware of any Commission determination relating to the permissibility of the Public Safety Spectrum Trust ("PSST") amending its current services fee arrangement with Cyren Call or of a Commission determination about how and when the PSST will be permitted to retire incurred debt obligations to Cyren Call and other third-party vendors.
