Pursuant to Section 64.1120(e) of the Commission's Rules, this letter provides notification to the Commission of the pending transfer of corporate control and contemplated name change affecting the local exchange subscriber base of Citizens Telephone Company of Brevard NC ("Citizens"). Rock Hill Telephone Company dba Comporium intends to acquire control of Citizens and operate under the tradename "Comporium." In accordance with Commission requirements, the following information is submitted herewith:

1. Transferring Carrier: Citizens Telephone Company of Brevard NC ("Citizens")
Acquiring Carrier: Rock Hill Telephone Company dba Comporium ("Comporium")
2. The types of services to be provided to the affected subscribers: Local exchange
3. Expected date of transaction: December 1, 2008

Dear Citizens Telephone Company Customer:

You have probably learned by now that Citizens Telephone Company ("Citizens") and its affiliated businesses CITCOM and Sylvan Valley CATV are being purchased by Comporium, a communications company based in Rock Hill, SC. Comporium ranks as the 18th largest telecommunications provider in the nation. We intend to continue providing local service to you under the trade name "Comporium."

When all necessary regulatory approvals are obtained and the transaction is completed, you will remain a customer of Citizens, doing business as Comporium. We anticipate that the transaction will be completed on or around December 1, 2008, but no sooner than 30 days from the date of this notice. Of course, you will not incur any charges for this change.

The Federal Communications Commission requires us to inform you that you have the right to transfer services to another provider, if an alternative provider is available. Citizens dba Comporium will be responsible for any carrier change charges associated with the transfer if the transfer occurs before or within 30 days after the close of the transaction. You can choose to take no action, which will result in your services remaining with Citizens. Even though there will be no change in your long distance carrier(s) as a result of this transaction, the FCC's rules require us to inform you that all "freezes" are lifted as part of this acquisition process. You should contact Citizens dba Comporium if you wish to arrange for a new freeze.

If you don't take any action before the transaction closes:

- You will remain a customer of Citizens, which will, after the transaction, begin doing business as Comporium.
- The rates and terms of your service will remain the same, and the company will inform you of any subsequent changes in accordance with regulatory requirements.
- Your telephone number will *not* change.

For now, you should continue to pay your local Citizens Telephone Company bill just as you have been doing. Once the transaction is complete, you will begin receiving a monthly statement from Citizens dba Comporium. If you have any questions regarding this transaction, you can call us toll-free at 1-866-547-5048. For questions related to your current service, please continue to use the same telephone numbers that appear in your local directory for reaching a Citizens Telephone Company representative.

The current owners of Citizens Telephone Company have valued your business and will continue to serve your local telecommunications needs until the changeover is complete. The Comporium group has a long history of providing high-quality telecommunications service at affordable rates, and we look forward to continuing that tradition in the Transylvania County area. It is our goal to make this transaction smooth and effortless. We will continue to inform you of developments as they occur.
