On Monday, November 3, 2008, Michael Altschul, Senior Vice President and General Counsel, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, and Brian Josef, Director, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association®, met with Kris Monteith, Bureau Chief, and George Dillon, Deputy Bureau Chief for Field Operations, of the Federal Communications Commission's Enforcement Bureau, to discuss the unauthorized use of wireless jamming equipment. As indicated in the attached presentation and consistent with its prior advocacy, CTIA urged the Commission to continue to actively enforce the federal ban on the sale or use of wireless jammers, except to and for the Federal Government.
