This letter is submitted on behalf of Inmarsat plc to clarify the wording of a sentence in the above-referenced application in Appendix D (Petition for Declaratory Ruling), page 6.

The text at the bottom of page 6 under the heading "Inmarsat plc" states that "[e]ach entity that owns or controls 10 percent or more of the equity interests in, or the voting power of, Inmarsat plc has its place of formation or principal place of business in the United States, the Cayman Islands, Ireland or the United Kingdom."

The text should read as follows: Each entity that owns or controls 10 percent or more of the equity interests in, or the voting power of, Inmarsat plc has its place of formation and principal place of business in the United States, the Cayman Islands, Ireland or the United Kingdom.
