The Filer, Indigo Wireless, Inc., is the license holder of Cellular Broadband PCS Licenses WPYS971, WPYS972, WPYS973, and WPYS974. Pursuant to the Commission's Hearing Aid Compatibility Report and Order in WT Docket No. 01-309 (rel. August 14, 2003), Indigo Wireless hereby submits the following report to the Hearing Aid Compatibility ("HAC") of its wireless handsets.

By way of background information, the filer is a small, Tier III Commercial Mobile Radio Service Licensee. Indigo Wireless currently provides service to customers via a GSM air interface using handsets manufactured by Sony Ericsson, Nokia, and Motorola. Indigo Wireless is compliant with the implementation requirements of the order for our service provided under the GSM air interface.

With respect to the specific information sought by the Commission, Indigo Wireless states as follows:

- 1) **Digital Wireless Phones Tested:** Indigo Wireless has not tested any digital wireless telephones for HAC compliance. Indigo Wireless relies on handset manufactures to test handsets for compliance with the ANSI C63.19 standard.
- 2) **Laboratory Used:** None: See response to item 1.
- 3) **Test Results for Each Phone Tested:** Not applicable. See response to item 1.
- 4) **Identification of Compliant Phone Models and Ratings According To ANSI C63.19:** Indigo Wireless currently offers the following seven handsets with lower RFS emissions that meet the M3-T ratings under ANSI C63.19:

- 5) **Report on the Status of Product Labeling:** Indigo Wireless relies on handset manufactures to label all products prior to delivery.
- 6) **Report on Outreach Efforts:** Indigo Wireless has point-of sale materials in our retail stores, which will allow the customer to easily determine which HAC compliant handset models are available and the M rating of each model.
- 7) **Information Related to Retail Availability of Compliant Phones:** M3 and M3-T handsets are available for the GSM air interface. Indigo Wireless's HAC phone offerings are currently stocked.
- 8) **Information Related to Incorporating Hearing Aid Compatibility Features into Newer Models of Digital Wireless Phones:** Indigo Wireless has no information on this topic. The handset manufacturers can only supply this information.
- 9) **Activities Related to ANSI C63.19 / Other Standards Work:** Indigo Wireless is not involved in activities related to standards work.
- 10) **Total Number of Compliant and Non-Compliant Phone Models Offered:** Indigo Wireless currently offers seventeen (17) wireless handsets, of which eight are UT3 rated M3 or T3.

- 11) **Differences in handset offerings among regions in service areas, if any:** There are no differences in handset offerings among regions in Carrier's service area. Carrier's handset offerings are presently consistent in all markets.
- 12) **Ongoing Efforts for Interoperability Testing with Hearing Aid Devices:** None
