

On November 20, 2008 I met with Mr. Greg Orlando, Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate on behalf of Great Plains Communications, Inc. of Blair, Nebraska to discuss comprehensive universal service and intercarrier compensation reform.

We discussed Commissioner Tate's interest in adopting a comprehensive order in December, as well as Great Plain's appreciation to the Commissioner for putting the draft orders out for comment. We expressed support for Commission action in December along the lines of the consensus items discussed in the statement released by the majority as well as Great Plains' concerns regarding moving all traffic to 251(b)(5) and the resulting elimination of access charges.
