On Friday, November 14, 2008, Mike Starling, NPR Chief Technology Officer and Executive Director of NPR Labs, and the undersigned met with Rick Chessen, Senior Legal Advisor to Commissioner Capps to discuss NPR Labs' recently filed studies measuring consumer digital television ("DTV") receivers and, in particular, the level of interference to television channel 6 from signals transmitted by NCE-FM stations operating on reserved FM channels. The parties discussed the improved performance capabilities of DTV receivers and the prospects for reexamining the existing interference protection requirements.
