COMMENTS

Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus"), by its attorneys, hereby submits these Comments pursuant to Section 1.420(g) of the Commission's rules. These Comments are being submitted in response to the Public Notice released on November 7, 2008 (DA No. 08-2459) inviting competing expressions of interest in Channel 272C2 at The Dalles, Oregon. Portland Broadcasting LLC, et al. ("Petitioner") has requested, *inter alia*, the substitution of non-adjacent Channel 272C2 for Channel 224C3 at The Dalles, Oregon, and modification of the Station KSMW(FM) accordingly.

Cumulus has previously expressed interest in Channel 272C2, and these Comments reaffirm its continued interest in Channel 272C2. In its Reply Comments submitted in MB Docket No. 05-10,¹ Cumulus stated that should this channel become available, it would "have an

interest in and would file an application for [the channel] and would participate in an auction for that channel should it be so assigned.”² These Reply Comments were accompanied by the Declaration of Lewis W. Dickey, Jr., Chairman, President and CEO of Cumulus, confirming its interest in the channel.

Cumulus hereby confirms its continued interest in Channel 272C2. Cumulus will promptly apply for Channel 272C2 should it become available. If authorized as the permittee of Channel 272C2, Cumulus will promptly build out the station. This continued interest is confirmed by an updated Declaration of Lewis W. Dickey, Jr., attached hereto.
