Yesterday, Charlie Hunter, of Broadview Networks, Inc., Brad Lerner of Cavalier Telephone, Lisa Youngers and Heather Gold, of XO Communications, LLC, and Brad Mutschelknaus and the undersigned, of Kelley Drye & Warren LLP, met with Commissioner Adelstein's Senior Legal Advisor, Scott Bergmann.


The participants urged the Commission to adopt an approach to harmonizing interstate and intrastate access charges that preserves competition. A five-year transition plan for reducing intrastate switched access charges to interstate levels was proposed. The participants also urged the Commission to retain the TELRIC methodology as the basis for establishing uniform intercarrier compensation rates. Finally, the Commission was urged to reject proposed changes to interconnection architecture rules and to avoid prospective classification of IP-PSTN traffic as Information Services.
