COMMENTS FOR PETITION FOR RULEMAKING

Henry B. Shaffer, pursuant to §1.415 and §1.419 hereby submits Comments supporting his Petition for Rulemaking which proposes to allocate new channel 260A to Williston, South Carolina.

The Commission has previously determined that Williston, South Carolina, was a bona fide community due to licensed station WAAW, facility ID 4094, being already assigned to the community. Williston is deserving of a second local service station as the proposed channel will provide additional diversity and an outlet for local residents. Therefore, the proposal is in the public interest.

Channel 260A can be allotted to Williston at reference coordinates 33°-23'-34" N x 81°-23'-21" W consistent with §73.207 of Commission Rules with respect to all existing and proposed allotments and facilities.

Petitioner has previously tendered FCC Form 301¹ for the requested channel along with the requisite filing fee². Should the Commission authorize channel 260A at Williston, South Carolina,


Petitioner will participate in the auction process, and if successful in obtaining a construction permit, will promptly construct and operate the proposed station.
