This letter provides notice that on December 4, 2008, Harold Furchtgott-Roth of Furchtgott-Roth Economic Enterprises, as well as Kurt Schaubach and Jennifer McCarthy of NextWave Wireless Inc. met with Commissioner Robert M. McDowell and Angela Giancarlo, Chief of Staff & Senior Legal Advisor, Wireless & International, regarding the above captioned proceedings.

The participants discussed the need for resolution of the above-referenced rulemaking proceeding in which changes are proposed to the technical rules governing both SDARS in Part 25 and WCS in Part 27 to enable coexistence of both services. Further delay in adopting appropriate rules may jeopardize WCS wireless broadband equipment development, network design, and service deployment and contribute to the need for another extension of the WCS substantial service deadline.

NextWave also responded to questions regarding the similarities and differences between the technical issues under consideration in the WCS-SDARS and the AWS-3 proceedings.
