Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on December 5, 2008, James Blitz, Vice President and Regulatory Counsel of Sirius XM Radio Inc. ("Sirius XM"), discussed issues associated with the above-captioned proceedings with Angela Giancarlo.

The parties discussed the recently reported proposal that would relax the out-of-band emission limits for WCS mobile devices and grandfather some satellite radio terrestrial repeaters. Consistent with Sirius XM's numerous filings in this docket, Mr. Blitz expressed concern that the "stepped mask" contained in the draft item, which is exactly the same as one that was originally submitted into the record by WCS interests, would not protect the 19 million satellite radio subscribers from harmful interference caused by WCS out-of-band emissions. Mr. Blitz stated that Sirius XM's analysis showed that additional protection above the levels that are contained in the draft order would be needed to prevent harmful interference to millions of satellite radio consumers.
