Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on December 5, 2008, representatives of Sirius XM Radio Inc. ("Sirius XM") discussed issues associated with the above-captioned proceedings with Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein and Renée Crittendon.

Sirius XM participants were Patrick Donnelly, Executive Vice President and General Counsel, and James Blitz, Vice President and Regulatory Counsel, who were joined by Richard Wiley and the undersigned from Wiley Rein LLP on behalf of the company.

The parties discussed the recently reported proposal that would relax the out-of-band emission limits for WCS mobile devices and grandfather some satellite radio terrestrial repeaters. The Sirius XM representatives said that the reported "stepped mask" proposal does not represent a compromise but, in fact, is exactly what was proposed by WCS interests and would not protect the more than 19 million existing satellite radio subscribers from harmful interference caused by WCS out-of-band emissions.
