Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 9, 2008, Jerry Johnson, on behalf of RLJ Equity Partners and the undersigned, met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate to discuss the status of the AWS-3 proceeding. During the meeting, Mr. Johnson shared RLJ Equity's support for the nationwide lifeline broadband proposal as detailed in RLJ Equity's November 19th *ex parte* letter. Mr. Johnson also explained that lifeline broadband service in the AWS-3 band would be in the public interest and that the AWS-3 auction should be used to promote new entry. Moreover, because the AWS-3 spectrum would be subject to aggressive build out requirements, the rapid conclusion of the proceeding would provide tangible benefits including jobs and increased telecom investment in these uncertain economic times.
