
On November 14, 2008, Rina Hakimian, an attorney for the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration ("SAMHSA"), filed a letter with the Federal Communications Commission seeking clarification of a statement in the Kristin Brooks Hope Center's ("KBHC") letter of November 12, 2008. In that letter, KBHC stated that "KBHC and SAMHSA are engaged in ongoing discussions that may result in the settlement of the dispute." In her letter, Ms. Hakimian stated that she was unaware of any "ongoing discussions" between the parties.
