This letter provides notice that on December 10, 2008, Harold Furchtgott-Roth of Furchtgott-Roth Economic Enterprises, as well as Kurt Schaubach and Jennifer McCarthy of NextWave Wireless Inc. met with Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate regarding the above captioned proceedings.

The participants discussed the need for resolution of the above-referenced rulemaking proceeding in which changes are proposed to the technical rules governing both SDARS in Part 25 and WCS in Part 27 to enable coexistence of both services. Further delay in adopting appropriate rules may jeopardize WCS wireless broadband equipment development, network design, and service deployment and contribute to the need for another extension of the WCS substantial service deadline.

NextWave also responded to questions regarding discussions between the WCS Coalition and NTIA regarding WCS emissions into the 2360-2390 MHz band.
