Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on December 10, 2008, James Blitz, Vice President and Regulatory Counsel of Sirius XM Radio Inc. ("Sirius XM"), discussed issues associated with the above-captioned proceedings with Angela Giancarlo of Commissioner McDowell's office.

Mr. Blitz reiterated the positions that Sirius XM has expressed in its recent ex parte filings, relating to the draft proposal that would relax the out-of-band emission limits for WCS mobile devices and grandfather some satellite radio terrestrial repeaters. Mr. Blitz said that the draft proposal does not represent a compromise but, in fact, is exactly what was proposed by WCS interests and would not protect existing satellite radio subscribers from harmful interference caused by WCS out-of-band emissions. Mr. Blitz also said that although the satellite radio industry has waited for years for the Commission to conclude Docket 95-91, no similar urgency exists to modify WCS rules as proposed in Docket 07-293.
