On December 11th, 2008, the undersigned, as Chairman of the Telecommunications Industry Association Private Radio Section (PRS), along with Al Ittner, President of the Land Mobile Communications Council (LMCC); Ralph Haller, Chairman of the National Public Safety Telecommunications Council (NPSTC); and Mark Crosby, President/CEO of the Enterprise Wireless Alliance (EWA) met in person with Scott Stone and Melvin Spann of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (WTB), Brian Butler of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (PSHSB) and through concurrent telephone connection with Tracy Simmons and Terry Fishel of the WTB Gettysburg Office to discuss a number of issues associated with the "narrowbanding" requirements that have been adopted affecting both licensees in the spectrum below 512 MHz and the manufacturers of equipment to be used in the spectrum below 512 MHz.
