**FIRST CONSOLIDATED STATUS REPORT
OF INTRADO COMMUNICATIONS OF VIRGINIA INC.**

Intrado Communications of Virginia Inc. ("Intrado Comm"), by its attorneys, respectfully submits this First Consolidated Status Report in response to the request from staff of the Wireline Competition Bureau ("Bureau") of the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission"). This report provides information regarding the status of negotiations between Intrado Comm and Central Telephone Company of Virginia and United Telephone - Southeast, Inc. (collectively, "Embarq"), including the status of other state arbitration proceedings pending between Intrado Comm and Embarq. The following activities have occurred since Intrado Comm's Seventh Status Report filed in WC Docket No. 08-33 on December 4, 2008:

- On December 10, 2008, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio issued an Entry on Rehearing in the Ohio arbitration proceeding between Intrado Comm and Embarq. A copy of this decision is set forth in Attachment 1.
- On December 18, 2008, Intrado Comm filed a petition for reconsideration of the December 3, 2008, Florida Public Service Commission final order in the Florida arbitration proceeding between Intrado Comm and Embarq. A copy of this filing is set forth in Attachment 2. The December 3, 2008 Florida commission order was included with Intrado Comm's Seventh Status Report filed in WC Docket No. 08-33 on December 4, 2008.

This report also provides information regarding the status of negotiations between Intrado Comm and Verizon South Inc. and Verizon Virginia Inc. (collectively, "Verizon"), including the status of other state arbitration proceedings pending between Intrado Comm and Verizon. In addition to the arbitration proceeding before the Bureau, various affiliates of Intrado Comm and Verizon are currently conducting arbitration proceedings in Delaware,¹ Florida,² Illinois,³ Maryland,⁴ Massachusetts,⁵ North Carolina,⁶ Ohio,⁷ and Texas.⁸ Pre-filed testimony has been

filed in the majority of these proceedings and hearings are scheduled in January for Maryland, Ohio, and Massachusetts, in February for Delaware and Illinois, and in March for North Carolina and Florida. Intrado Comm and Verizon are currently discussing the possibility of waiving the arbitration hearings in Delaware and Illinois. In Texas, the parties are awaiting a decision by the Administrative Law Judges on several threshold legal issues, including Intrado Comm's right to a Section 251(c) interconnection agreement.

Intrado Comm and Verizon recently concluded an arbitration proceeding in West Virginia, and the following documents are attached in connection with that proceeding:

- On November 14, 2008, an Administrative Law Judge with the Public Service Commission of West Virginia issued a recommended decision in the West Virginia arbitration proceeding between Intrado Comm and Verizon. A copy of this decision is set forth in Attachment 3.
- On November 21, 2008, Intrado Comm filed exceptions to the West Virginia recommended decision. A copy of this filing is set forth in Attachment 4.
- On November 21, 2008, Intrado Comm and Verizon filed a conforming interconnection agreement as required by the November 14, 2008 recommended decision. A copy of this filing is set forth in Attachment 5.

- On December 16, 2008, the Public Service Commission of West Virginia issued a final order in the West Virginia arbitration proceeding between Intrado Comm and Verizon and approved the interconnection agreement filed on November 21, 2008. A copy of this decision is set forth in Attachment 7.
