Kimberly Baum of Motorola, Inc., JoAnne Dalton of Tyco Electronics, and Mary Brown of Cisco Systems, Inc. participated in three meetings on the above-captioned docket: on December 18, 2008, with Renee Crittendon of Commissioner Adelstein's office, and on December 19, 2008, with Erika Olsen of Chairman Martin's office and separately with Bruce Gottlieb of Commissioner Copps' office.

In the meetings, the industry representatives urged the Commission to adopt a Report and Order finalizing the 4.9 GHz issues raised in the proceeding. Industry representatives stated that the 4.9 GHz issues are non-controversial and the record reflects significant agreement among public safety and industry. Furthermore, the lack of clarity in the Commission's existing rules, which the Notice proposed to address, has created uncertainty in the market about how 4.9 GHz systems can be tested and deployed.
