As such, we have developed substantial information about defendants and their modes of faxing illegal advertisements. One of the leading defenses raised by faxers is that an Established Business Relationship exists, and thus, they can send faxes. They often rely upon such argument notwithstanding our client may not have done business with that company in furtherance of an "established business relationship" (for example using an inquiry about a product), in many years.

Often, companies misuse the "established business relationship" when in fact, our client has not been in contact with them for many years.

As such, it is respectfully suggested a time limit be placed upon companies to rely on an EBR, for example, a maximum time of 18 months, and this way, consumers have the capability to stem the flow of unsolicited faxes coming from unwanted vendors.
