

indicated that the report covering the calendar quarter ending December 31, 2008 would be due by January 12, 2009.

For the quarter ending December 31, 2008, VTel has not implemented consumer outreach efforts for any customers on services relating to the 700 MHz License because it does not have any such customers. VTel has not yet had the opportunity to purchase equipment or deploy services on the 700 MHz License. Nevertheless, VTel has implemented consumer outreach efforts regarding the DTV transition for its Lifeline and Link Up customers as required by the Commission's rules and has even gone beyond what the rules currently require. DTV transition information is included in monthly bills sent not only to Lifeline/ Link Up customers, but to all customers that receive services from VTel (*i.e.*, telephone and Internet customers). VTel has also placed that information prominently in its 2008-2009 Telephone Directory which is now in use. Finally, VTel has posted a link to the FCC's DTV transition page on its company website homepage.

Pursuant to the Commission's rules, VTel will continue to report its consumer outreach efforts regarding the DTV transition on a quarterly basis.
