Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 3, 2005, the Commission issued an *Order* granting Southern Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a SouthernLINC Wireless (“SouthernLINC Wireless”) a limited waiver of Section 20.18(g)(1)(v) of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 20.18(g)(1)(v), providing SouthernLINC Wireless with a limited extension until November 3, 2006, to achieve 95 percent penetration of location-capable handsets among its subscribers.¹ On December 5, 2005, SouthernLINC Wireless filed a Petition for Reconsideration requesting that the Commission reconsider and/or clarify its November 3, 2005 *Order*. This Petition for Reconsideration remains pending before the Commission.

Since November 2006, the Commission has granted SouthernLINC Wireless further extensions of the 95 percent handset penetration deadline up through September 8, 2008, the date on which SouthernLINC Wireless achieved 95 percent penetration of location-capable handsets among its subscribers.²

Accordingly, SouthernLINC Wireless, through its undersigned counsel, respectfully withdraws its December 5, 2005, Petition for Reconsideration in the above-referenced docket.
