This is to advise you that on September 3, 2008, Ad Hoc Telecommunications Users Committee ("Petitioner") filed a Petition for Review in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a), of the following order: *In the Matter of Qwest Petition for Forbearance Under 47 U.S.C. § 160(c) from Title II and Computer Inquiry Rules with Respect to Broadband Services*, WC Docket No. 06-125, Memorandum Opinion and Order, 23 FCC Rcd 8834 (2008).

Petitioner challenges the above-referenced order, in which the Commission grants Qwest Corporation forbearance from dominant carrier regulation and certain Computer Inquiry requirements with respect to specific broadband services.
