

SUBJECT: *Qwest Corporation v. FCC & USA*, No. 08-1257. Filing of a Petition for Review in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

This is to advise you that on July 28, 2008, Qwest Communications ("Petitioner") filed a Petition for Review in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a), of the following order: *In the Matter of Petitions of Qwest Corporation for Forbearance Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 160(c) in the Denver, Minneapolis-St. Paul, Phoenix, and Seattle Metropolitan Statistical Areas*, WC Docket No. 07-97, Memorandum Opinion and Order, 23 FCC Rcd 11729 (2008).

Qwest seeks review of the FCC's order denying its petitions for forbearance from dominant carrier regulation, unbundling requirements and computer inquiry obligations in the Denver, Minneapolis-St. Paul, Phoenix and Seattle MSAs.
