SUBJECT: *William B. Clay v. FCC & USA*, No. 08-1255. Filing of a Petition for Review in the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit.

This is to advise you that on July 28, 2008, William B. Clay ("Petitioner") filed a Petition for Review in the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a), of the following order: *In the Matter of Revision of Procedures Governing Amendments To FM Table of Allotments and Changes of Community of License in the Radio Broadcast Services*, MB Docket No. 05-210, RM-10960, Report and Order, 21 FCC Rcd 14212 (2008).

The radio frequency Table of Allotments that sets forth the communities served by commercial FM radio broadcast was abolished. Incumbent licensees will now specify a new community as a "minor change," not subject to public comment or petitions to deny.

William B. Clay challenges this order with a petition for review as well as a motion to stay the FCC's order pending judicial review.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 08-1255. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is William Scher.
