Your broadband/telephone company, Champion Broadband California, LLC ("Champion"), has entered into an agreement to transfer assets to CBC Broadband Holdings LLC ("CBC"). Our intent is to make this change transparent to our customers. CBC will continue to operate as Champion Broadband after the sale has been completed. The new company expects to introduce new high-speed data services and increased high definition channels.
