
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 16, 2009, Mr. David Donovan, Mr. Victor Tawil of the Association for Maximum Service Television ("MSTV"), and Mr. Larry Walke of the National Association of Broadcasters ("NAB") met with Mr. Rick Chessen, senior legal/media advisor to Commissioner Michael Copps.

We discussed MSTV/NAB's phased plan for removing licensed wireless microphones from operating on TV channels 52 – 69. We explained that our approach would ensure that there would be no interference to entities seeking to operate on these channels.

In addition, we discussed our concerns about allowing Clarity Broadcasting to operate "Trucker TV" on frequencies now reserved for electronic newsgathering and other BAS services.
