Joint Request for Special Temporary Authority to Operate Pending Approval  
Of Section 214 Transfer of Control Application

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 214, Powercom Corporation ("Powercom"), FRN: 0003745304, a nondominant domestic wireline common carrier, and Lambeau Telecom Company, LLC ("Lambeau") FRN: 0018383000 hereby request Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for a period of sixty (60) days to enable Powercom to transfer control of its customer base to Lambeau pending Commission approval of their joint application for transfer of control. Lambeau and Powercom request that the STA be granted as soon as possible, and not later than January 22, 2009, because of the exigent circumstances described below.

Powercom provides local exchange telephone service, including exchange access, to customers in Wisconsin pursuant to authorization granted by the Wisconsin Public Service Commission, and provides interexchange services in a number of other jurisdictions, with blanket authority under 47 C.F.R § 63.01. Recently, Powercom began experiencing financial difficulties and is under foreclosure by its secured debt holder. Due to these circumstances, Powercom is seeking to transfer its customers in good standing to Lambeau.

By agreement, Lambeau, as assignee of the debt holder, BCN Telecom, Inc. ("BCN"), will acquire the collateral including: (i) all of Powercom's Contracts; (ii) all of Powercom's Inventory; (iii) all of Powercom's Equipment; (iv) all of Powercom's Patents, Trademarks, and General Intangibles; (v) to the extent not otherwise included in the foregoing, all other personal property of Powercom, whether tangible or intangible, whether now owned or hereafter acquired and wherever located; and (vi) the Proceeds and Products of the foregoing.

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
Lambeau, a newly created subsidiary of BCN, is not currently authorized to provide telecommunications services in any jurisdiction, but is seeking authority to provide service in all jurisdictions where Powercom holds authorization.

By this request, Powercom and Lambeau are requesting that the Commission grant this request for Special Temporary Authority so that the transfer of customers may proceed as soon as possible. The proposed transaction will ensure that existing customers of Powercom will continue to enjoy uninterrupted service. Therefore, in light of the substantial benefits of Powercom's customers, as well as the financial hardship facing Powercom, Applicants request special temporary authority so that the transaction may close on January 22, 2009.

Powercom and Lambeau acknowledge that grant of the requested STA will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the Joint Application and that, once granted, the STA may be revoked on the Commission's own notice without hearing.
