Dear Ms. Dortch:

The purpose of this letter is to provide the Commission with supplemental information in relation to the above-captioned petition, as requested by Commission staff. Specifically, Commission staff has asked PRWireless, Inc. d/b/a Open Mobile ("PRWireless") to provide additional information for the record concerning the reason why PRWireless missed by one day the March 30, 2008, deadline set forth in section 54.307(c) of the Commission's rules for filing line count data for Interstate Common Line Support ("ICLS"), and the steps taken by PRWireless to prevent such incidents from occurring in the future.

PRWireless missed the March 30, 2008 ICLS filing deadline by one day due to circumstances that can be categorized as a good-faith misunderstanding. The March 30, 2008 due date fell on a weekend. PRWireless submitted its line count data the next working day, Monday, but USAC received such data on Tuesday. Based on previous communications with USAC officials, PRWireless personnel had the impression that the submission would be considered timely filed.

It is important to note that PRWireless has put in place procedures to ensure that it timely submits future ICLS filings, as it has done with all ICLS filings both before and after the filing that was due March 30, 2008. Specifically, PRWireless has established an internal deadline for each ICLS report that is three weeks before the relevant FCC-established deadline. PRWireless therefore fully expects to submit its future ICLS filings when due.
