Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Thomas J. Sugrue, Kathleen O'Brien Ham, and the undersigned of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") met with Scott M. Deutchman and Paul Murray, Acting Senior Legal Advisor and interim Advisor for Wireless and International Issues, respectively, to Acting Chairman Michael J. Copps, to discuss the Commission's tentative conclusion that the wireline and intermodal porting interval should be shortened to 48 hours.

T-Mobile reiterated its support for a maximum interval of one business day, noting that carriers opposing Commission action have pointed to no operational or technical barriers to implementing this shorter interval. The T-Mobile representatives stated that the company would not oppose a longer implementation period or other possible exceptions for small carriers, but urged the Commission to put this long-overdue item to a vote as soon as possible. A copy of the attached PowerPoint presentation was distributed at the meeting.
