On February 18, 2009 the undersigned, counsel to GE Healthcare, spoke via telephone with Renée Crittendon, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Adelstein. During the call, I noted GE Healthcare's November 7, 2008; October 30, 2008; and September 18, 2008 filings in this docket and indicated GE Healthcare's view that the compatibility issues for consideration in the 2360-2390 MHz band are sufficiently narrow at this point to warrant a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("NPRM") on GE Healthcare's MBANS proposal.
