Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 24 and 25, 2009, Sean Belanger and John Harris of CSDVRS, and Karen Peltz Strauss, outside counsel for CSDVRS, held meetings with FCC offices to raise concerns about problems with the FCC’s requirement for VRS equipment to be ported from one provider to another. The attached document, which summarizes these concerns, was provided to these offices. In addition, concerns were raised about current violations of the FCC’s prohibition against having more than one provider give out ten digit numbers for the same devices. Participants discussed whether the FCC should revise its policy to permit such competing numbers in order to allow consumers to receive “dial arounds” for incoming calls.
