Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.1206(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules, this is to report that an *ex parte* oral presentation was made on February 26, 2009, with respect to the above-referenced pending petition for rule making.

The presentation was made by representatives of the **Community Broadcasters Association** ("CBA") to representatives of the **Media Bureau**, including Robert Ratcliffe and Eloise Gore.

The purpose of the meeting was to present the results of a survey of the ownership characteristics and programming activities of Class A and Low Power Television ("LPTV") stations and to suggest several ways to provide relief to these stations from the economic pressures they face from being excluded from Multichannel Video Program Distribution systems. During the discussion, I noted that RM-10335 could assist of some Class A and LPTV stations in protecting their intellectual property rights and observed how long the petition has been pending. Later in the day, I provided the file number of the petition to Ms. Gore.
