Dear Ms. Dortch:

On February 27, 2009, Professor Angela Campbell, Coriell Wright and Jessica Gonzalez of the Institute for Public Representation, and Andrew Jay Schwartzman of the Media Access Project, met with Chairman Michael Copps and his legal advisor, Rick Chessen.

The principal topic of discussion was the media ownership proceeding. Mr. Schwartzman discussed Common Cause *et al.*'s pending petition for reconsideration in that docket. In addition, the parties updated the Chairman and Mr. Chessen on the litigation stemming from the media ownership order. Professor Campbell underscored the importance of public notice of newspaper-broadcast cross-ownership waiver requests.

Professor Campbell also addressed the enhanced disclosure rules. She emphasized the importance of the rules in providing valuable information to the public and the FCC regarding television broadcaster service to their local communities. She also stressed that broadcasters' arguments regarding the burden of complying with the disclosure rules are grossly exaggerated.
