REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

HC Cable OpCo, LLC (“NuLink”) (FCC Registration Number (FRN) 0018602078 / EIN: 262115127) respectfully requests a 45-day extension of time to April 30, 2009, to complete and file the revised Form 477 due March 16, 2009.

NuLink acknowledges the importance of the information being requested by FCC in the revised Form 477 as well as the need to have this information provided in a timely manner.

However, the information being requested in the revised Form 477, and the related information gathering process, represents significant departures from that required to complete the previous form. As such, the process of completing the revised Form 477 has placed a substantial burden and hardship on NuLink to complete by March 16, 2009.

NuLink was purchased from Newnan Utilities in April 2008. We have also recently entered the phone business. Due to these circumstances, I would like to request this extension.

NuLink is a medium sized internet, cable, and phone provider based in Newnan, Georgia with approximately 17,000 customers. NuLink has filed all past Form 477s in a timely manner. However, the census tract data now required in the revised Form 477 is not currently being tracked by NuLink.

NuLink is committed to providing the information required in the Form 477, and continues to devote employee time to completion of the Form 477 as quickly and accurately as possible. However given the amount and nature of the information being requested, NuLink does not believe it has the time or resources to accurately complete the Form 477 by March 16, 2009. With a 45-day extension to file NuLink believes it can accurately provide all the requested information, as well as establish the needed

procedures to more efficiently prepare future Form 477s. By granting this extension to NuLink, the Commission would be benefiting the public interest by allowing NuLink to provide more accurate data.

In conclusion, for the foregoing reasons, NuLink requests the Commission grant it a 45-day extension of time to submit its revised Form 477 filing, currently due March 16, 2009. If the Form 477 is successfully completed prior to the expiration of the 45-day extension, it will be submitted at that time.
