proceedings. See Implementation of the DTV Delay Act, et al (*Second Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*), FCC 09-11, released February 20, 2009. TracFone's waiver petition was filed February 24, 2009.

TracFone hereby restates and reincorporates the alternative DTV notification proposal set forth in its waiver petition with the following modifications:

1. TracFone will send to each of its Lifeline customers two SMS text messages per month during the months of April, May, and June, 2009 (as well as one SMS message during March 2009) reminding those customers of the impending DTV transition.

2. The SMS text message sent to TracFone's Lifeline customers will state as follows:  
"Be ready for the DTV transition 6/12/09. Call 1-888-CALLFCC for add'l information."
