In accordance with the Consensus Plan filed in ET Docket No. 05-345 on April 9, 2007 by the Nuclear Energy Institute and the Utilities Telecom Council in their Supplement to Petition for Waiver and referred to in the referenced Experimental Licenses, Exelon Generation Company, LLC (EGC) is providing a report consistent with 47 CFR 5.73, "Experimental report."

Specifically, in accordance with Section IV, "Licensing and Reporting Requirements," paragraph D of the Consensus Plan, EGC confirms that the subject nuclear stations have engaged in local frequency coordination, to the extent required, and limited the use of the Telex Equipment at these nuclear station locations to only those circumstances permitted under the Consensus Plan. Further, the subject nuclear stations have operated in compliance with the Special Conditions set forth on Licenses 0252-EX-RR-2008, 0253-EX-RR-2008, 0249-EX-RR-2008 and 0251-EX-RR-2008.
