

We have had a TV Guardian for more than 6 years now. We're actually on our second one, as we broke the first one and didn't want to do with out.

I would very much like to have the TV Guardian more readily available. Specifically, we cannot watch movies with our children on our computers or over the internet as we would like to do if those movies have any bad language.

In our experience, closed-captioning is generally accurate enough for the TV Guardian to be useful. There are a few times that it has not blocked out at the right time, but not many. We wouldn't watch a PG/R Rated movie without it.

If TV Guardian was no longer available to us, we would discontinue viewing of any movies besides those rated for general audiences, and we would strictly limit the viewing of television programs, or cut it out completely.

It would be more than worth it to our family to pay a few dollars each month for TV Guardian features in cable.
