

My family has used TV Guardian for a few years now. It has opened up several programs to my children that I would otherwise not have allowed them to watch. I like that one can select the level of "strictness" for the device. If it becomes obsolete or were unavailable, I and my family would view/purchase fewer movies/videos/cable channels/etc. If it were expanded to include internet or other data devices, it would allow us to broaden what we allow in our household.
