

TV Guardian has had a tremendous impact on my family's lives specifically my children. Today's children's TV shows and movies don't always have the best language. Why this is the case is beyond me but it is the truth. Most children's movies have adult themes and language that is geared towards adults. I DO NOT WANT MY CHILDREN EXPOSED TO THESE ADULT THEMES AND LANGUAGE and TV Guardian is the only way to shield my children from these adult themes and language outside of not letting them watch these programs at all.

I would like to see TV Guardian offered as an option on my paid TV subscription and built into my DVR and TV tuner (including HDTV) so that all programming on TV can be filtered of inappropriate language. Without a service like this being offered soon I may have no choice but to cancel my paid TV subscription.

The closed captioning on current TV programs is very compatible with TV Guardian and very accurate as well. Anytime unwanted language is presented in a program the TV Guardian device I have mutes it and shows similar words on the screen that isn't offensive or inappropriate for children.

If TV Guardian were not added to all devices (such as TVs, DVD Players, Blu-Ray players, cable, satellite, computers, the Internet, cell phones, iPods/Mobile Video Players, Gaming Consoles (Xbox/PS3/Wii), DTV converter boxes, and DVRs) I would probably cancel my paid TV subscription at some point.

My request is that the FCC make a law that requires that the TV Guardian feature be built into all devices (such as TVs, HDTV, DVD Players, Blu-Ray players, cable, satellite, computers, the Internet, cell phones, iPods/Mobile Video Players, Gaming Consoles (Xbox/PS3/Wii), DTV converter boxes, and DVRs) so that my children can watch children's TV shows and movies and not be exposed to undesirable adult and foul language.

I would be willing to pay extra to have the TV Guardian service on all my devices mentioned above.

Please make this happen so that our children grow up being better people.
