

I have used TVGuardian extensively for over 5 years and am very happy that the device is available. Unfortunately, television and films are more and more laced with foul language, detracting from experience of watching the shows. If the intent of the Media complex is to make our society crude and our common language profane then they are doing a fine job. For those of us that would like to avoid the constant bombardment of foul language and its effects the TVGuardian is a valuable aid. I would love to see it offered broadly, on every medium and every video delivery vehicle. It's as accurate as the closed captioning, which is very good for prerecorded shows and ok for live shows.

I also use the ClearPlay DVD player, which uses a filter to eliminate or silence foul language and foul content. Now that PG-13 movies contained graphic nudity and are no longer appropriate for teenagers the number of movies available for viewing by youth is limited. ClearPlay provides custom filter settings which allows us to set our limits, and ease them as our kids get older. This is a must have for parents that care enough about their kids to control what they watch.

I hope to see TVGuardian and ClearPlay filtering available broadly in the very near future.
