Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 27.1236 of the Commission's Rules, Waltonville Community Unit #1 is writing to notify the Commission of its intent to self-transition the Educational Broadband Service ("EBS") license WLX711 in Basic Trading Area ("BTA") 308. We are aware that this BTA has had a transition initiated and a post-transition notification filed by the proponent, but that proponent's documentation and transition did not include our station.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, out of an abundance of caution Waltonville Community Unit #1 is going to proceed to self-transition our facilities.

Waltonville Community Unit #1 will comply with the remaining requirements of Section 27.1236 of the Commission's Rules, including providing notice of the intent to self-transition to other licensee's in the Mount Vernon-Centralia, IL BTA and working through interference issues.
