

I do not watch television without my TVGuardian. I do not watch DVD or VCR movies or recordings without my TVGuardian. I've used it for many, many years beginning when my children were very young. We do not go to movie theaters but wait for the release on DVD so that profanity can be eliminated. Some DVD movies do not have close caption available or it's not detected by TVGuardian because of some non standard formatting. We don't view these DVDs but take them back for a refund.

I was extremely saddened recently after trying to purchase three additional stand alone TVGuardian units. They are no longer available as stand alone units. Why must my only choices be (one) exposing myself to unlimited amounts of profanity while watching TV and movies or (two) not watching at all. Why can I not chose (three) watch without the profanity.

My family and I would not have owned a television, DVR, DVD, or VCR over the past 15 years without a simple standalone TVGuardian unit. A unit that is no longer produced or available. If my TVGuardian breaks or is rendered obsolete by advancing technology, I'll sell all my TV related equipment and not watch TV or movies.

TVGuardian type filtering should be a requirement for all devices that produce anything that displays on my television or even my computer via the internet. A few extra dollars per device or a few extra dollars for cable access would be acceptable if this filtering was available. All non-live shows and movies should be accurately closed captioned so that devices like TVGuardian can work even better.

Why is it so difficult to shelter children from profanity when the technology is available? I'm a 49 year old man and do not want to expose myself either.

Please consider giving parents control for their children and for themselves.
